



- What is First Responder ID?** First Responder ID is a standardized repository for identification and information related to emergency personnel. REJIS designed this system to create ID cards, with personnel information and skills, for immediate identification during emergency events. A card is issued from First Responder ID which is recognizable as a standardized form of identification by many law enforcement, fire and EMS agencies in the Greater St. Louis area.
- Who can have a card?** Any employee, volunteer or retired individual identified as qualified to carry a First Responder ID by a participating agency.
- What is on the card?** Work designation, personal description, photo and agency. Agency type is further differentiated by color with police highlighted in blue and fire in red.
- How do we make a card?** Your agency must have secured access to REJIS and a trained First Responder Administrator. Your First Responder Administrator enters person data into the shared system. The card holder gets a photo taken and the photo ID is printed on a card.
- How do we get the cards?** Cards are printed at REJIS and sent to your agency.
- Who will take the photo?** ID Photo for badge can be taken with any digital camera. Once taken, upload the photo into the First Responder ID system. Any agency with a REJIS Media Services Capture station can also take the photo.
- Who trains an Administrator?** REJIS provides free training for any designated First Responder Administrators.
- Where is the training class?** REJIS Commission – REJIS is located at 4255 West Pine, St. Louis, MO 63108 Corner of West Pine and Boyle in the Central West End.
- How much does it cost?** One time setup fee and a nominal fee for card printing is charged. Training is free. (Contact REJIS for fees.)
- How do we access it?** Access requires a PC with browser in addition to connectivity with REJIS. REJIS law enforcement clients have this connection. Non-police emergency agencies can obtain web access connection using a secure VPN Token.
- What is REJIS?** Regional Justice Information Service is a government agency. We service Law Enforcement, Courts, Corrections and Government agencies for a variety of law enforcement data sharing applications and services. Contact the REJIS Help Desk for additional information. 314-535-9497.
