

Prosecuting Attorney Management System

PAMS was created as a stand-alone prosecutorial case management system to provide a manageable work-flow for municipal prosecutors and prosecutor assistants. This system has the mechanism in place to satisfy the division of duty requirements as set by the state. PAMS gives the prosecutor an automated issue and refusal process while still retaining the history of the original citation, summons and parking violations. PAMS has the capability to interface with other judicial and law enforcement software for more accurate entries and reporting options.

- Tickets and informations can be manually entered into PAMS
- Interface option to OSCA Show-Me Courts System
- Capability in place for interface with Missouri Highway Patrol (MSHP) for fingerprint reporting
- Supports ticket review and prosecutor approval prior to official filing in any municipal court system
- Allows the creation for an Attorney Recommendation
- Provides the capability for prosecutorial notices, letters, labels, reports and case jackets
- Allows for entry of witness, victim, and complainant information, along with the ability to produce subpoena notices
- Provides officer notification for trials
- Access to DOR driver registration files for review of driver license information
- Contains electronic audit trail for tracking modifications and deletions
- All data resides on a secured server located at REJIS. The server, license(s), data back-up, monitoring and security patches are included as part of this service
- Promotes a "go green" reduction of paper use and expenses
- Scanning and document storage capability
- PAMS training is available

The REJIS Commission is a local government agency created to "serve the public interest through delivering quality, cost-effective technology services to the justice community and to government and quasi-government agencies." REJIS' primary focus is to provide record management services to law enforcement, courts and corrections agencies at the local, state and federal levels. This includes interfaces to the Missouri State Highway Patrol MULES system; Missouri Department of Revenue (DOR); the National Crime Information Center (NCIC); the Kansas KCJIS and KDOR; and Nlets networks. REJIS was founded in 1974 under a cooperative agreement between St. Louis County and the City of St. Louis. Primarily concentrated in the metropolitan St. Louis and Kansas City areas, we service criminal justice agencies in Missouri, Kansas and Illinois.
